## **Unequal Economic Opportunities**

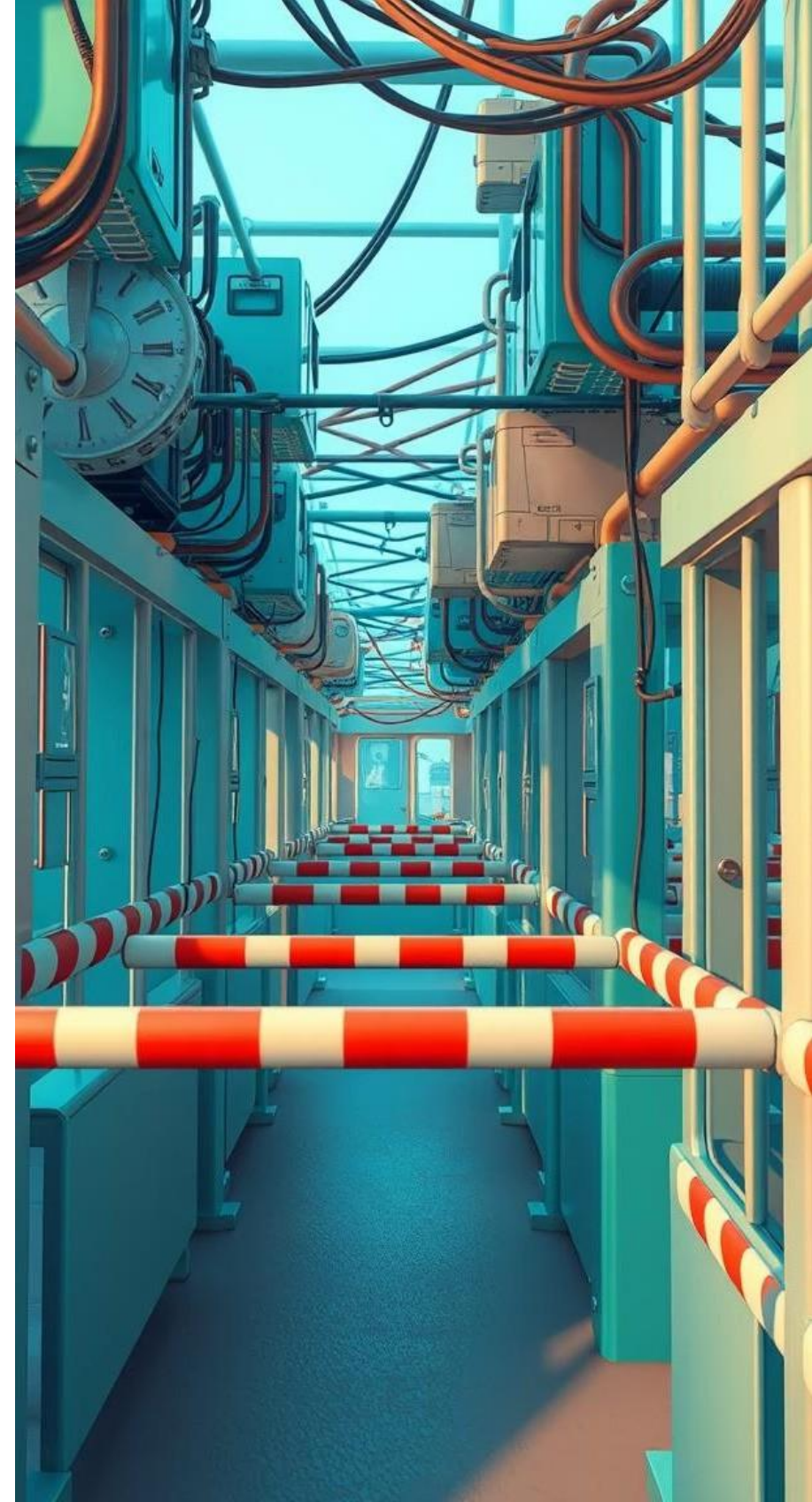
Wage gaps, limited access to lucrative jobs, and biases affect all genders.
